



General Terms & Conditions All Star and School Events/Competitions

These General Terms & Conditions apply to each JAMfest Europe event and competition (live and virtual) (collectively, "JFE Event") for Varsity All Star and schools. If an individual JFE Event has additional terms and conditions specific to such JFE or competition, refer to those terms and conditions as well.

PRICING PERIODS

All Events:

1. ****NEW THIS YEAR**** Teams must register and pay a £200 deposit per programme/gym/studio prior to 01/11/24 to receive the Early registration period rate. 01/11/24 is the Early Deadline for all events in the 24-25 season. Deposits are non-refundable.
2. Payment types accepted for registrations: Bank Transfer
3. Additional teams added to registrations after the early registration period deadline will be charged standard Registration period rate.

PAYMENTS

1. Full payments are due for all events on the following dates:
 - a. Rise of the Regions: Thursday, 16/01/25
 - b. JAMfest Northern JAM: Thursday, 06/02/25
 - c. Scottish JAM: Thursday, 17/04/25
 - d. JAMfest Europe: Thursday, 08/05/25
2. If full payment is NOT received by said deadline, your registration may be removed from the event and teams that are on the event waitlists will be added in place.
3. **All teams competing in World's divisions at JAMfest Europe (Manchester), must pay a £200 deposit per team to secure their spot by 1st April 2025. This is an additional £200 after the registration deposit. An invoice will be sent all programs with payment information.**
4. Payment may be made to JAM Brands Europe via bank transfer to the bank details on the invoice. Payments cannot be made online on MyVarsity at this time. All invoices will be emailed to the Registration Contact in MyVarsity.
5. **Teams may not be included on the order of competition if full payment has not been received by the deadline date above.**

DIVISION CHANGE FEES

1. The following fees will be charged for changes made after Monday at 5:00 PM, three weeks prior to the JFE Event:
 - Teams: £300
 - Cheer/Dance Specialty Divisions: £50 (when offered)
2. The following fee will be charged per change for changes made the week of the JFE Event:
 - Teams: £500
 - Cheer/Dance Specialty Divisions: £75 (when offered)
3. Division changes include, but are not limited to, Coed to All Girl, XSmall to Small, Prep to Elite, level changes, age changes (Junior to Senior), Pom to Jazz (styles).

REFUND POLICY

1. Athletes or teams that cancel will receive a refund if the cancellation is received as follows:
 - a. Refunds will be given if the cancellation for athletes or full teams is made 31+ days prior to the JFE Event for all teams.
2. No refund will be given if cancellation for athletes or full teams is made 30 or fewer days prior to the JFE Event for all teams.
3. Refunds will be processed and paid after the JFE Event is over. Refunds will be in form determined by JAMfest Europe.
4. Note: See the TRANSFER POLICY below for JFE Event transfer options.



TEAMS TRANSFER POLICY

1. JAMfest Europe will allow transfer of monies paid, for full teams, to another JFE Event during the 2024-2025 season pursuant to the following:
 - a. Notification to JAMfest Europe must be made 22-30 days prior to the JFE Event transferring from to transfer 100% of monies paid.
 - b. Notification to JAMfest Europe made 0-21 days prior to the JFE Event transferring from will transfer 50% of monies paid.
 - c. Transfers may only be made to JAMfest Northern JAM, JAMfest Scottish JAM and/or JAMfest Europe. No transfers can be made to any events outside of the United Kingdom.

Note: If you have not paid and cancel your registrations 0-21 days prior to the competitions you could be assessed a £250 cancellation fee per team.

CREDITS

1. If an account has a credit balance at the end of the season following accounting for refunds and/or transfers, as applicable, the credit will be processed following the end of the season. Credits will be paid in form determined by JAMfest Europe.

RESULTS

1. Posting of results:
 - a. Results for JAMfest Europe events will be posted in the event BAND.
 - b. By participating in a JFE event, teams give their consent for scores to be made public.
2. Varsity TV publishes and makes available all competition routine videos from live-streamed JFE Events to recognize the hard work and talent of the athletes competing, and ultimately, to serve and grow the cheerleading and dance community. Due to the sheer number of teams and routines published, Varsity Spirit is unable to accommodate requests for removal.

**Not all events will be live streamed on Varsity TV.*

ACCOUNT STANDING

All accounts must be in good standing for a team to attend a JFE event. Teams whose accounts are not in good standing will not be bid eligible.
